

The throat plate on all of our models can be taken out with ease, enabling the cleaning of the flueways and the chimney without the inconvenience of removing other internal fireparts. All our stoves are tested in Australia and comply to AS/NZS 2918:2018 for clearance safety and to AS/NZS 4012/4013 (2014) for emissions and efficiency testing on Australian Hardwoods ensuring the very best in efficiency, safety, design and construction.



The Island range is available in two sizes as the Island II and Island III.







ISLAND II

This can be installed directly on a concrete hearth, or added on any of the three matching bases for a look to suit any home.





RIDDLING GRATE

The Charnwood riddling grate is the very best grate system on the market. Built into all Arc and Island models, the grate can be altered to ensure the most efficient burning conditions. By operating a lever on the side of the stove with the tool provided, a series of grate bars can be set into a closed, flat bed position (the most efficient way to burn wood) or to an open grate for ultra efficient burning. This grate also acts as a highly effective riddling mechanism, neatly dropping the ash into the wall-to-wall pan below for clean disposal. Because the grate is operated externally, all of these manoeuvres can be carried out with the doors closed and when the stove is fully loaded and under fire.

CLOSED POSITION for wood & peat - allowing a bed of ash to build up to let the air flow across the fire.

OPEN POSITION for smokeless fuels - allowing the air to flow up through the fuel. In this position the open bars facilitate easy ash removal whether burning wood or solid fuel products.



OPTIONAL EXTERNAL AIR KITS

The external air kits are a range of devices that enable an outside air supply to be channelled directly into your Charnwood. As well as providing further



comfort and operational efficiency for your wood heater, our air kits help overcome issues where the room requires an additional air supply. They are available for all Aire, Arc, Bay and Island.

HEAT SHIELDS AND CONVECTION PANELS

All Charnwood wood heaters are fitted with Charnwood's rear heat shield standard. This steel heat shield allows rear wall clearances to be reduced.



TOP OR REAR FLUE

The Aire, Island and Arc models all have the option of being rear or vertically flued.

Also available as another option is a vertical rear flue adaptor which enables you to position the stove further away from the wall behind.



This will add a depth to the stove of between 115-196mm depending on the model.

QUATTROFLOW® AIR MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

This is a revolutionary air management system patented by Charnwood and used on the Aire, Arc, Island and Bay models. Using a number of air chambers the single control introduces the right amount of air into just the right places for ultra efficient burning and optimum control: pull out to increase the burning rate - push in to slow it down. An outside air supply can be channelled directly into the stove through the rear of the Quattroflow® box.




When choosing your wood heater it is important to pick the right size for your room.

TOASTING FORK

The perfect gift for any fanatic.

The Charnwood Toasting Fork is a neat, highly effective stove accessory designed for use on all our models.

Simply place the magnetic holder onto the stove top and suspend the fork in front of the glass for perfectly toasted bread, muffins or crumpets. The fork and holder is British made from stainless steel with a turned beech handle.



COOKING PLATE

The Charnwood Cooking Plate is a cast iron plate that simply replaces the flue blanking plate on a standard Charnwood heater to create a highly effective hot plate for cooking.

The Cooking Plate is ideal for wood heaters installed into open-plan living areas where the boundaries of cooking, dining and lounging are merged.

The set includes cast iron trivets for versatility when cooking. The plate can fit multiple saucepans and suits most Charnwood models.

Please note: the heater will need to be installed using the rear outlet to allow the cooking plate to fit on the top.



HEATER POD

The Charnwood Heater Pod is a freestanding hearth and enclosure designed for use with our Aire 3 wood heater. The Pod is a quick and easy way to create an instant fireplace, so is perfectly suited to cabins, yurts, houseboats and other types of tiny home accommodation.

The Charnwood Heater Pod can be safely placed 50mm away from combustible materials. It is finished in a durable black powder coat but we also offer the option of a Vlaze 'Splatter' vitreous enamel to further enhance the enclosure (pictured right).



FIRE BALL

The Charnwood Fire Ball is a self-assembly, sculptural outdoor fire pit with a rustic finish.

This iconic piece is cut from mild steel and supplied as a boxed flat pack kit making it the perfect present for someone who enjoys a small project. The satisfaction of building this product is all part of the experience. All that is required is an hour of your time, a pair of pliers, gloves and a hammer.

The Charnwood Fire Ball will oxidise over time turning a rich, auburn colour blending into the natural surroundings. This is all part of the design and character of the product.





VLAZE

Luxurious vitreous enamel for the fireplace

VLAZE offer a range of vitreous enamel hearths and wall mounted heat shields designed specifically to reduce the clearance on any wood heater. British made by our sister company AJ Wells & Sons, the exceptional surface finish is created by fusing powdered glass to steel at temperatures in excess of 800°C. The result is a luxurious, vibrant glaze that boasts excellent thermal properties, does not crack, distort or discolour when exposed to the heat of the stove and wipes clean. The VLAZE process and finish is identical to that of which AJ Wells & Sons use to manufacture the iconic signage and architectural cladding for The London Underground.

VLAZE HEARTHS create a clean, modern platform on which to stand your wood heater. An excellent alternative to a standard tile or marble hearth they can be used on their own, or alongside our heat shields for a seamless floor to wall solution. Each hearth features a smooth radius edge and is insulated with fire rated fibreboard to take the heat and weight of the wood heater while still being light to handle. The plates are available in 2 sizes, 1,050mm x 1,050mm and 1,200mm x 1,200mm to suit most heaters and a 12mm depth.

VLAZE WALL MOUNTED HEAT SHIELDS are designed to be placed behind a wood heater. When installed the shield reduces the heaters rear clearance to the face of the panel by up to 80%. The vitreous enamel panel features a dual skin that provides thermal protection and an effective convection system. Using a rail mounted system, they are quick and easy to install. The heat shield is available 1,050mm wide x 1,200mm high to suit all our models.

The heat shields and hearths plates are available in a choice of three finishes including our standard Black, Off White Crackle White and a Black & White Splatter.
